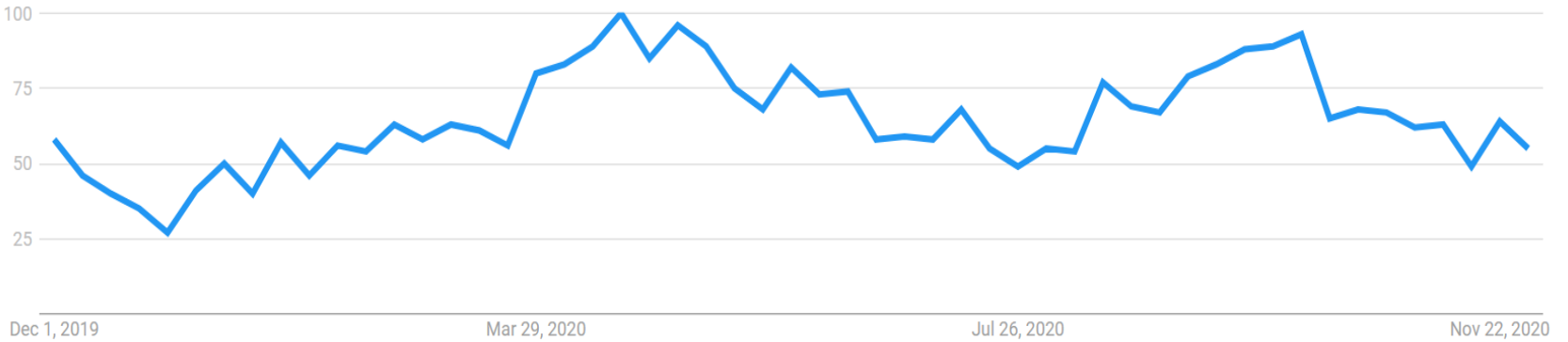

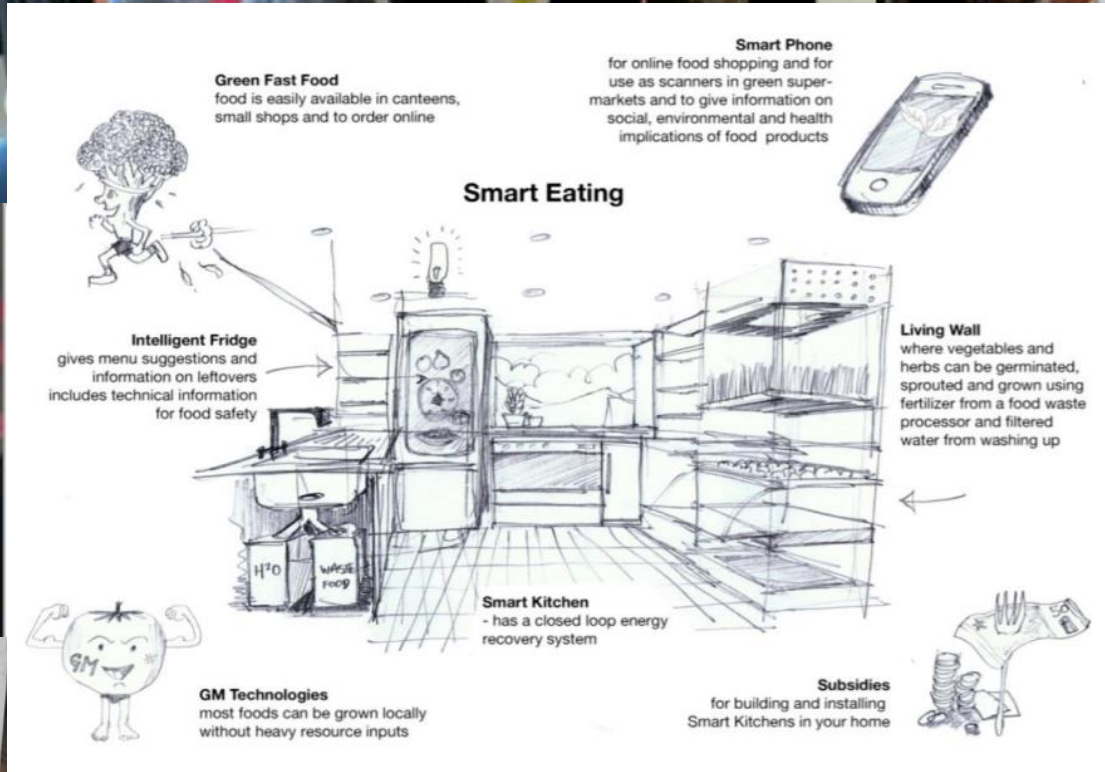

Who are we: building an alternative local food chain together

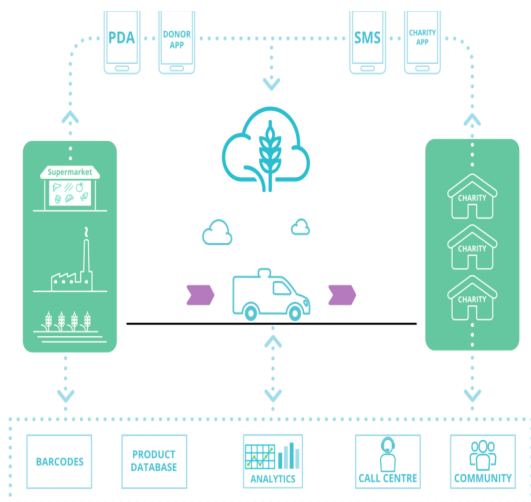

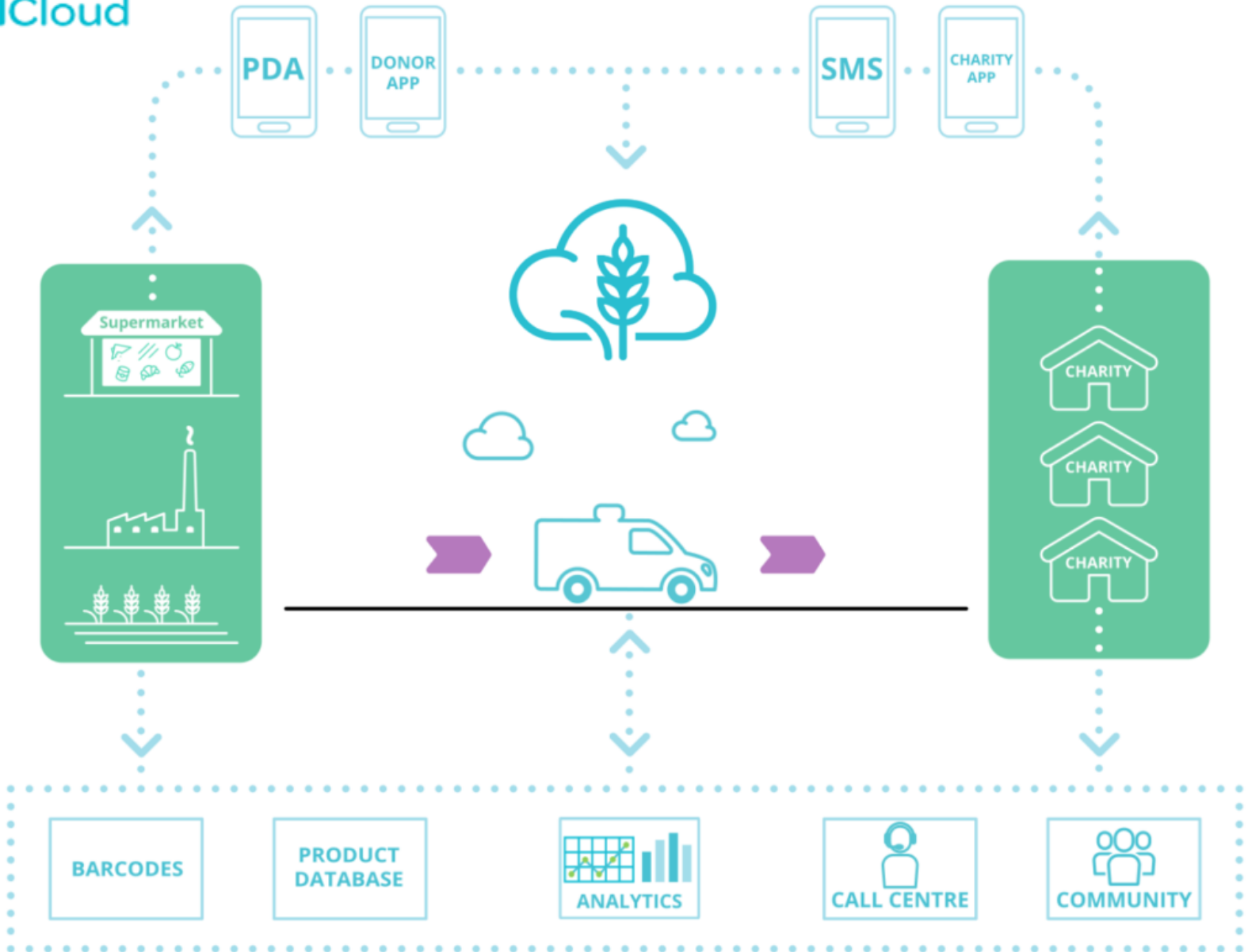



